- ⇒ Absentee ballot applications can be requested from the Town Clerk or downloaded from the Town website under general information Town Clerk. All ballots must be mailed back, returned in person or by a spouse, parent, child or sibling - you will need to sign a form with the Town Clerk). Any ballot found at the Town Hall not returned as specified by the law WILL NOT BE COUNTED!! Ballots must be received by 5 pm the day before the election if returned in person, if mailed then by 5 pm the day of the election. November 8.
- ⇒ One can register to vote and actually vote on election day. Please bring a government issued photo ID and proof of residency with you at that time.
- ⇒ When coming to vote please bring your government photo ID with you.
- ⇒ When paying your tax bill please include the bottom portion of the bill so that it can be credited to the correct property. If you are one of several owners and are sending in your portion without the bottom portion of the bill or are using an online banking service please put the Lot and Map number or address of the property in the memo line. If the person sending in the check is not the first name on the bill, I don't know which property to credit.
