- The general election will be held on Tuesday, November 3<sup>rd</sup>. We again encourage you to vote absentee. We have spoken to the folks at the Gorham Post Office who have assured us that election mail is kept in their office and treated as high priority. The turnaround time of a ballot placed in your mailbox to the Town Hall should not be longer than two days. Nevertheless, you should plan to vote as early as possible.  
 If you have not already filled out and returned the request for an absentee ballot for the general election, please do so soon. If you did not receive the request form, or have mislaid it, please call the Town Office (at 466-5771) and let us know that you need to have one sent to you.  
 Ballots will be sent out to all those requesting them as soon as the Town receives them from the State, which should be early October at the latest. That should provide ample time to put your ballot in the mail in order for it to reach the Town Hall, and be counted on Election Day. If you are concerned about mail collection, you can go to the Gorham Post Office and either use its drop box, or watch your ballot letter stamped. In unusual cases, you can contact the Anne Kenison, the Town Clerk, and arrange to have your ballot handed to her in person. **David Willcox, Town Moderator**
